Supplies

Painting Supports:

1 sheet 22"x30" 140lb coldpress watercolor paper

3 primed stretched canvases (choose from the following sizes):

16x20, 18x24, 20x24, 22x28, 24x30, 24x36

Several small canvas boards (choose from the following sizes):

8x10, 9x12, 10x14, 12x16

*You may need to purchase additional painting supports as needed.

Pigments (oil or acrylic):

Alizarin crimson red

Cadmium red light or medium

Cadmium yellow light

Yellow ochre

Thalo green (phthalocyanine)

Burnt Sienna

Ultramarine blue

Thalo blue

Prussian blue

Titanium White

I also enjoy having the following Pigments in my palette:

Cadmium orange

Naples yellow

Permanent green light

Sap green

Burnt umber

Raw umber

Brushes:

White natural bristle brushes #12-F (or B), #10-F, #6-F, #4-F, #8-B, #2-R

One 3" house painting brush

Medium (if using oil paints):

237ml Galkyd or 75ml Liquin Original

500ml Eco-House Neutral Thin or Extra Mild Citrus Cleaner

*PLEASE NO MINERAL SPIRITS OR TURPENTINE!!!

Medium (if using Acrylic Paints):

16oz Golden Regular Matte or semi-gloss Gel or Liquitex Glazing Medium

Golden Acrylic Glazing Liquid •optional

Golden Molding Paste *optional

Other Supplies:

- 1 double pane glass palette (minimum 11" x14")
- 1 quart Acrylic gesso
- Palette knife (2 if possible, one flat and one like a trowel)
- 1 single-edge razor blade or paint scraper
- 1 Silicoil brush cleaning tank
- 1 small glass jar with lid
- Saran wrap to cover paint
- Latex or Nitrile gloves (optional)
- 1 sketchbook (no smaller than 9" x 12")
- 1 tool box or tackle box to hold paint tubes and brushes (cheapest at a hardware store!)
- 1 roll blue painter's tape
- Several graphite pencils/sharpener and kneaded eraser
- Several rags (old cut-up t-shirts work great)
