\*Paper- Arches 140 lb. cold pressed 22" x 30" (No Substitution Please)

\*18" x 24" Masonite Board (14" x 18" minimum),  $3/_8$  "or 1/4" thickness

\*Watercolor containers (plastic jar) two, 64 oz size

\*¾" blue painter's tape

\*Paint- Grumbacher 7.5 ml watercolor paint

-Burnt Umber and Ultramarine Blue

-Alizarin crimson permanent and Cadmium red hue

-Pthalo blue

-Lemon yellow and yellow ochre

\*Palette (white) i.e. butcher tray 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" or 11" x 16". White plastic palette tray with raised edge OK

\*Paper towels

<u>\*Brushes</u> (Make sure they are Watercolor brushes) i.e. Connoisseur, Princeton, Robert Simmons, Cotman)

-Flat - ½ "or ¾"

-Round - #10 or #12

-Round - #5 or #6

-Round - #3 or #4

\*Pencils: H & HB

\*Erasers: 1 kneaded & 1 rubber
