Spalding House Gardens
Overview/Purpose:
As a Spalding House garden volunteer, you will be part of a group of enthusiastic volunteers who appreciate historical and beautiful gardens with a rich local history. Here, volunteers will learn the history of this Japanese stroll garden, and find meaningful assignments that support one of Honolulu's most treasured destinations.
Activities/Duties:
Volunteers play an integral role in keeping the gardens beautiful by assisting our garden staff with – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deadheading (removal of dead flower heads); • Debris removal; • Weed control; • Planting/transplanting; • Cutting/trimming; • Manicuring; • Raking; • Fertilization; • General garden upkeep.
Desired Qualifications:
Garden experience is a plus, but not necessary. Must be physically able to do light garden work including bending, stretching, and light lifting in a sunny outdoor setting. Volunteers should wear closed-toe shoes, comfortable breathable clothing, and bring their own hats and sunscreen. Volunteer Services will provide drinking water, insect repellent, and all the necessary gardening tools.
