These are the supplies you will need for the first class. A few other items will be discussed that day for subsequent classes.

## **Supplies**

<u>Gloves</u> –Kim chee gloves (pink) from the Korean market are best (very long, inexpensive) –Dishwashing gloves are OK Fabric

-white or lightly colored cloth (natural fibers only) -6 pieces 12" x 12" for the first class -more yardage for subsequent classes (don't cut yet)

Sewing needles -the longer the better

Dental floss –unwaxed, 1 box –or very strong white thread such as quilting thread (do not use regular sewing thread)

<u>Rubber bands</u> -small to large, thin to wide

Plastic basin or bucket for holding and rinsing dyed fabric
