Japanese Scroll Mounting Workshop

Instructor: Hiroko Sakurai

Welcome to the Workshop! I hope you would enjoy making your own hanging scroll.

On the first day of the workshop, please bring.....

A: one piece of artwork to mount. It has to be...

- Flexible and thin enough to roll up tightly. Paper or fabric are good but not canvas.
- Able to absorb water since most process use water and the adhesive will be water-based.
- Made with not-runny ink or color for the same reason above. Sumi ink is usually no problem unless it was recently.
- Smaller size is easier for beginners. The recommended size....less than around W14x H18 inches.

B. one piece of Fabric for borders it has to be....

- Thin cotton, silk or other mixed material cloth matching to your artwork
- Smooth surface preferable (to stick with paper)
- Able to absorb water, please wash it beforehand if it has starch or color is very runny.
- Size is depends on your design of scroll. If you art work is (width) A X (Height)B inches, you need about W(A+6) X H(B+20)inches piece for standard design (top and bottom borders are long)

And, Please bring fabric scissors if you have a good pair....
