Illustration Supplies:

If you have a personal supply of some of these items, feel to bring in what you have, instead of purchasing extra.

*The asterisk means this is good to have but is optional.

- 1. *Small adjustable desk lamp for lighting.
- 2. A small prop i.e. a small box to elevate/position your specimen if you need it
- 3. *Hand held magnifying glass
- 4. *A "divider" or transparent 12" ruler for measuring
- 5. *Mechanical pencil with 0.5 HB lead, Pentel P205 or similar
- 6. Pencils: Graphite 2H, HB, 2B
- 7. Manual or Electric Pencil Sharpener
- 8. Vinyl eraser, Sanford Magic Rub or similar
- 9. Spiral bound sketchbook approx. 9x12"
- 10. *Tracing paper pad 9 x 12"
- 11. High quality <u>Hot Press (HP 140 lb</u>) watercolor paper. Sold in blocks or single sheets. Hot press we paper has a smooth surface which is good for highly detailed work. You can bring cold press if you prefer. It has a textured finish. Recommended brands:
 - a. Arches or Fabriano (HP means hot press which is smooth)
 - b. Blocks should be no smaller than 9" x 12". Single sheets are large (25" x 36") and can be cut down to size required. You will not need more than a single large sheet for this class.
- 12. Round watercolor brushes, synthetic (for longer lasting) or Kolinsky sable (higher quality)
 - a. Like Sceptre Gold II series, approx. sizes can be 1, 2, 4, 6. If you only bring two-bring a 2 and 6.
- 13. Palette: white china plate, Chinese butcher tray palette, or porcelain lotus flower palette
- 14. Watercolors: bring your favorite palette. If you don't have colors you like already, pick at least **one of each group**, or similar:
 - a. Yellows:
 - i. Lemon Yellow
 - ii. Winsor Yellow
 - iii. Cadmium Yellow Hue
 - b. Oranges:
 - i. Cadmium Orange Hue
 - ii. Cadmium Red Pale Hue
 - c. Reds:
 - i. Winsor Red
 - ii. Alizarin Crimson
 - iii. Permanent Rose
 - iv. Quinacridone Magenta
 - d. Purples:
 - i. Dioxazine Purple
 - ii. Dioxazine Violet
 - e. Blues:
 - i. Ultramarine
