It is essential that you be able to see details of your work so visual aids such as reading glasses, Optivisors, or similar things are recommended. If you have questions, please contact the instructor.

Basic Tool Kit

- Half round file. #0 Swiss cut
- Half round file, #2 Swiss cut
- Pliers: chain, round, flat
- Flush cutters
- Sand paper-320, 400, 600
- Paint stir sticks or wood molding for making sanding sticks (paint stir sticks are sometimes free in hardware store if you ask)
- Needle file set, cut 2
- Ruler

- Pencil
- Sharpie
- Scissors
- Containers for solder chips
- Paper for drawing and notes
- Clear packing tape
- Masking tape
- Rubber gloves
- Face mask
- Eye protection
