Jewelry I: Basic Fabrication

A basic tool kit is available for use in the studio. However, if you wish to do work at home as well, some personal hand tools are nice to have. It is essential that you be able to see details of your work so visual aids such as reading glasses, Optivisors, or similar things are recommended.

Basic Tool Kit:

- Half round file, #0 Swiss cut or similar
- Half round file, #2 Swiss cut or similar
- Pliers: chain, round, flat
- Flush cutters or wire cutters
- Sand paper-320, 400, 600
- Paint stir sticks or half round wood molding for making sanding sticks (paint stir sticks are sometimes free in hardware store if you ask)
- Needle file set. cut 2

- Ruler
- Pencil
- Sharpie
- Scissors
- Masking tape
- Small containers for solder chips
- Paper for drawing and notes
- Face mask
- Eye protection

Some hand tools, metal sheet and wire are available for purchase; limited to stock on hand.
